- 2. An essay, one page typed, explaining your career goals and how your educational plans will further them. Include life experiences and challenges.**
- 3. Two letters of reference from any of the following: teacher, employer, counselor, or community person.**
- 4. A student copy of your most recent academic transcript.**
- 5. Financial Budget (use form included).**
