She should plan to enroll in at least 8 credit hours each term in her first undergraduate degree program (not post-bacc). Selection will be based on the applicant's financial need, academic achievements, career goals, work experiences, community activities, honors and awards.

To be considered, all of the following items must be submitted as requested.

- 1. A resumé using the format included with this application.**
- 2. A double-spaced typed essay (two pages maximum) explaining your career goals and how your educational plans will further them. Include life experiences and challenges. Please be specific.**
- 3. Two letters of reference from any of the following: teacher, employer, counselor, or community person.**
- 4. A student copy of your most recent academic transcript.**
- 5. Financial Budget (use form included).**

DEADLINE: Tuesday, April 5, 2011 (or postmarked April 5, 2011). Applications will be reviewed as they are received. All applicants will be notified by April 30, 2011
